Kathleen reported that the plumbing contractor who installed the hydrant is supposed to be here soon to troubleshoot the problem.

**Well:** The water tests all came back fine, but we still have the issue of whether it is deep enough. Jeff and Kathleen will be working on ways to move forward.

**Generator:** As of today we have not heard about the grant for which we applied. We were able to have school on 12/4 as the rented generator powered the school while PGE was off. If we choose to continue renting a generator large enough to run the school (120KW), it will cost about \$3,000 a month.

#### 7.2 Superintendent -

- o All staff were administered Covid tests on November 16th. All came back negative. We are waiting to hear if the nurses will be able to come back again in January.
- Kathleen gave kudos to Robin and Kristi. This has been an unbelievably uncertain and stressful year and they have stepped in and stepped up every day!
- Amber Equihua donated a plethora of masks, gloves, hand sanitizer, and face shields.
- 7.3 Business Robin reported that CalPads was certified and December payroll was complete.

- 11/10--School Picture Day--Jessica Crawford did a great job with the pictures; order forms went out last week.
- 11/16 2<sup>nd</sup> Trimester began
- 11/17-20 Parent Teacher Conferences went well
- 11/19 Kilgore's Classroom Feast was appreciated by students; no parents could attend :(
- 11/20 Student Award Assembly held at school, and some participated remotely
- 11/20 All students were served a delicious Thanksgiving Lunch prepared by Julie and Samantha Upcoming:
  - Virtual Winter Musical Presentation--Irene is putting this together
  - Santa's Workshop will still occur, but in the classrooms and will take place over a few days
  - 12/16—A community group will provide Santa's gifts for each student. They have come in person the past few years, but this year they will deliver the gifts to the school and our staff will give them out. This group usually provides gifts to students at all the local schools (BR, TV, Hoopa El and Creekside).
  - Classrooms are modifying their traditional classroom festivities to be COVID friendly, but seasonal activities are still occurring--Just slightly different.
  - 12/18 is a minimum day
  - 12/21-1/1--Winter Break
  - School is scheduled to resume January 4, 2021

#### Information:

- Three new students (in-district) enrolled Nov.30th/Dec.1; K, 4th, and 6th graders. One 3<sup>rd</sup> grader moved out of the area.
- 90% of students (64 out of 71) attending in-person classes. 10% (7 students) are in Distance Learning\*
  - \*We did have two students sign up for 4-weeks of DL, due to safety concerns regarding the holidays. 62 out of 71--87% and 13% (9 students) on DL until January 11th, 2021
- Continuing to update and redo the website to make it more user friendly and relevant. (ongoing)
